Re: NHOAI Board Coordination Regarding Anvaya's Emergency Medical Preparedness

Dear Mr. Cárdenas,

We hope this letter finds you well.

We write regarding the concern posted by the NHOAI board about the need to enhance Anvaya Cove's emergency medical response capabilities. We appreciate your continued advocacy for the health and safety of the community and acknowledge the Board's concerns on this matter as the same was also discussed with emphasis in several board meetings covering prior years and officially documented in your letter dated September 2, 2025.

We understand and share your sense of urgency in ensuring that Anvaya Cove will be able to address such concerns. Summarized as follows are the steps taken by the team:

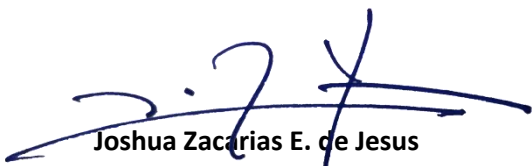
1. **Overall review of existing medical facilities and services** – We have tasked the team to do a full audit of existing resources and identify critical gaps that could be upgraded
 - A. **Audit**
 - On site Doctor, Dra. Diana Caga, is conducting a full site audit
 - Bernard Bibangco EMT Head at Baypointe Hospital, is assisting with the audit of the Emergency Response Vehicles (ERV)
 - NHOA Board Members, Dr. Albert Ablang and Mr. Che Cardenas, have helped spearhead a countercheck of the existing inventory and the full medical audit
 - Annex A: Attached is a table comparing the suggested improvements by NHOAI members as submitted by the NHOAI board to ALI last September 22, 2025.
 - B. **Inventory of Medicine, Supplies and Equipment**
 - Annex B-1 to B-3: Breakdown of existing Medicine, Supplies, and Equipment
 - Annex B-4: Immediate items to be added
 - Supplemental items to be added if there are any findings during the audit
 - C. **Emergency response vehicle**
 - Annex C-1: Breakdown of the existing ERV checklist of items

 - Supplemental items to be added if there are any findings during the audit

2. **Engagement of additional and capable Doctors at the site** – We are engaging with medical service providers who can deploy specialists and improve manpower capabilities at the site
 - A. **On-Site Doctors**
 - Dra. Diana Caga, now stationed on-site after the last major medical incident, is a licensed general practitioner with BLS, OSH, and ACLS certifications, and relevant urgent care experience, including beach- and water-related cases.
 - A second doctor is targeted to be deployed by the second week of October 2025 to extend clinic hours. The team is also assessing the feasibility of engaging an Emergency Response specialist as recommended by the NHOAI board.
 - B. **Emergency Response Team**
 - Annex D: List of Trainings and Qualifications of all of our Guards on Duty related to basic life and safety programs
3. **Future Plans** – The team has been working with several groups to explore possibilities of upgrading medical services and emergency response for the development
 - A. **ERV Upgrade**
 - Assessment ongoing; report expected by October 2025
 - B. **Emergency Transport Options**
 - Exploration of more efficient air, land, and water transport alternatives. Full report targeted for November 2025.
 - C. **Hospital Partnerships**
 - Continued engagement with Baypointe Hospital and the upcoming local government hospital across Anvaya. Meetings targeted for November 2025 to explore facility upgrades.
 - We will also look into other hospitals that can service our stakeholders
 - D. **Senior Care Programs with AC Health and Healthway**
 - Initial focus group discussions held in February 2025. Program implementation will depend on overall service assessments across ALI estates. Presentation of findings to ALI is targeted for December 2025.
 - E. **Expanded On-Site Services**
 - Exploring additional services for Anvaya Cove stakeholders and nearby barangays.

We have already implemented several improvements and continue to pursue long-term solutions to strengthen emergency medical response in Anvaya Cove.

Please rest assured that we take this issue seriously, and we are committed to working closely with the NHOAI Board to deliver a safer and more resilient emergency response framework for Anvaya Cove.

Thank you once again for your proactive leadership. We look forward to continued collaboration on this matter.
